

**AMENDMENT TO THE ANTIDUMPING SUSPENSION AGREEMENT ON CERTAIN
CUT-TO-LENGTH CARBON STEEL PLATE**


The United States Department of Commerce (the Department) and the Government of Ukraine hereby amend section XII of the Agreement Suspending the Antidumping Duty Investigation on Certain Cut-to-Length Carbon Steel Plate (CTL plate) from Ukraine (the Agreement), signed October 24, 1997, as amended on December 20, 2002, January 16, 2004, and November 24, 2004, as follows:

- XII. In order to provide for the continuation of exports of CTL plate from Ukraine to the United States following the expiration of the extension signed on November 24, 2004, by the Department and the Government of Ukraine, the export limits provided for in Section III of the Agreement shall remain in force through October 31, 2008, or until a new Agreement between the Department and the Ukrainian producers of CTL plate becomes effective.

The Government of Ukraine will not request and the Department will not grant any extensions of export limits under the current Agreement.

To the extent that there are any inconsistencies between this amendment and the Agreement, as amended, the provisions of the Agreement, as amended, are superceded, and the provisions of this amendment shall govern. All other provisions of the Agreement, as amended, and their applicability continue with full force.
